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

- Plan & facilitate airport modernization





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




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ALB Master Plan Components

- Airport Inventory*
 - Collection of available information and studies, field review of airport facilities, and interviews with airport operators
- Forecasts of Aviation Demand*
 - Projections of expected airport activity (aircraft operations, passenger enplanements, etc.) within the 20-year planning period

Facility Requirements

 Identifies existing and future demands and provides a comprehensive determination of airport facility requirements *Strategic input from TAC Members

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ALB Master Plan Components

- Airport Development Concepts*
 - Development alternatives for each component of the airport:
 Airfield, Terminal Area, Cargo, General Aviation, etc.
- Land Use Plan & Development Evaluation*
 - Land use planning for airport and surrounding area, addressing overall development compatibility.
- Airport Layout Plans (ALP)
 - Preparation of the formal ALP, the official documentation of potential projects (requires FAA approval)

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Airport Activity Forecasts



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
COVID-19 Impacts & Forecasts







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
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



















FAA Airfield Design Standards




Key Airfield Features


- Runway 1-19
 - -8,500' x 150'
 - Primary
 - Approach Lights
 - Instrument Landing Systems (ILS)
- Runway 10-28
 - -7,200' x 150'
 - Crosswind
- 15 Taxiways



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Long Term Airport Trends - Airfield

- The FAA Standards reduces eligibility for airfield pavement
 - -Fewer Runways (FAA AIP Handbook)
 - —Shorter Runways (modern aircraft design)
 - -Narrower Taxiways (FAA AC 150/5300-13A)

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ALB Wind Coverage Analysis



Wind Coverage %				
Wind Speed	Standard Analysis	Refined Analysis		
10.5 knots	90%	86%		
13 knots	94%	90%		
16 knots	98% 🖊	94%		
20 knots	99%	98%		

- FAA analysis Crosswind Runway 10-28 is only needed for GA aircraft (ARC B-II)
- Revised analysis:
 - Limited to wind 5AM to Midnight
 - Winter month (October to March)
- Crosswind Runway 10-28 is justified for B737 and A320 (C-III aircraft)

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
